### PLAY IT SAFE! Proper Care Can Prevent Flue Fires

Chimney fires can result in the loss of life and the destruction of a once beautiful dwelling.

The trouble is caused by the ignition of accumulated soot or fine carbon. Sparks may be carried to wooden shingles or other combustibles. If the chimney has no flue lining and there are cracks between the bricks, then the walls, floors or roof may be ignited.

Soft coal and wood, especially creosote-treated wood, are great producers of soot, as well as of sparks to ignite the soot. If you use such fuels, chimneys and flues should be cleaned every one or two years.

**PLAY IT SAFE!** Have the chimney checked and cleaned regularly. Burn the proper fuel in the proper amounts and install a spark arrester at the top of the chimney flue.
