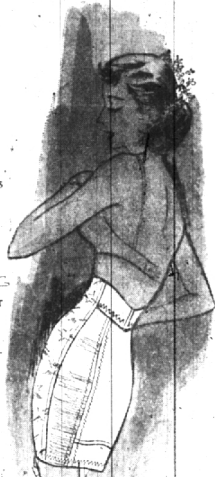

Troy Drive-Ins Cited For Noise

Troy township drive-in restaurant owners Monday night heard neighborhood protesters' moan against their operations at the township board meeting and pledged their cooperation in curbing noise and any unnecessary disturbances. Cyril Johnson, owner of Lolly's Drive-In, Richard James of the Kitty Korner Drive-In, and Anthony Deholl of Tony's Drive-Ins were present to defend their businesses at the meeting.

Resident opposition to car noise and blaring juke boxes were cited to the owners who agreed to do anything in their power to quiet patrons.

OWNERS COMPLAINED that they had no authority to ticket reckless drivers and little control over spontaneous horn-blowing incidents.

Board members instructed the owners to post signs at their businesses warning patrons of unnecessary noise and to cut off outside loud speakers at midnight.

Board members Clifton Truesdell and Harry Godfrey were appointed to a committee to work closely with restaurant owners in abating future disturbances.

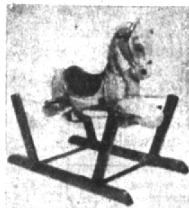
