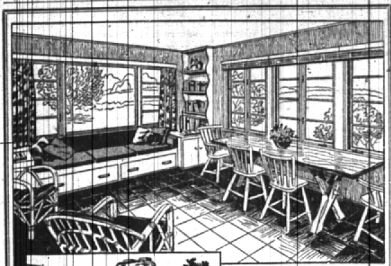


**Returns to School at 77**

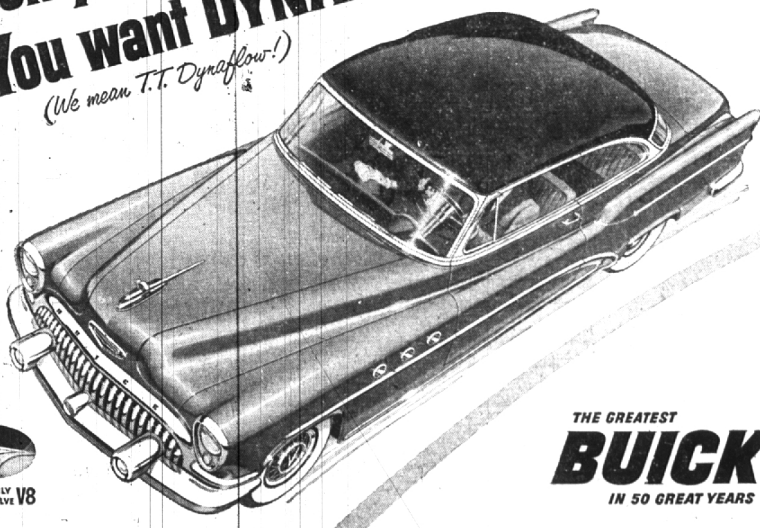
**OCTOBER OBSERVATIONS**  
We wish to call your attention to our Free D Service\* A few remarks about water softeners are in line. If your equipment is "direct salting" and contains "high capacity resin" you will probably get better results with either medium flake or pelleted salt. Never undersalt. If you require 27 lbs. per regeneration use 27 lbs. or more. If you use less the efficiency will go down.

We are gradually changing our salt containers from cotton to paper. We feel there must be enough dish towels and doll clothes now and the lower cost of salt in paper will be appreciated. (In a few instances we were wrong.) If you prefer cotton and are willing to pay the price of 25c more, let us know. If enough of you want it we will carry it—damn it.
