To Take Bids For Southfield School Addition

Bids for construction contracts for an addition to Southfield school at Berg and Ten Mile will be taken by the Southfield board of education at its Nov. 16 meeting, the board decided Monday night.

Plans approved by the board call for a minimum of six classrooms to be added to the school, plus a general purpose room to be used as a cafeteria, gymnasium and auditorium.

Also included in the plans are heating facilities and a kitchen.

Advertising for bids is slated for Oct. 22. If favorable bids are brought in, construction on the project is expected to begin before Dec. 1, according to Glenn Schoenhals, Superintendent of Schools.

IN OTHER business Monday night, the board approved an annual expenditure of \$200 for a director of the school's adult education program. Schoenhals announced this sum will be paid to William Adcock, who is presently

directing the adult program in addition to his duties as a high school teacher and part-time visual aids instructor.

The board also purchased six violins and two violas for the beginning of training in stringed instruments at the high school.

Also under discussion were plans for the first graduation of a senior high school class in the history of Southfield schools. It was decided that members of the faculty would not be attired in caps and gowns,

and that they would be seated on the main floor of the auditorium rather than on the stage.

Recommendation of Schoenhals for the payment of \$60 per month for classroom facilities at the Townsite Community church and the Southfield Presbyterian Church was approved.
