Scoreboard Fund Started Again By Legion Post

A fund-raising campaign to install an electrically operated football scoreboard at Pierce field has been reported by the Charles Edwards American Legion Post.

Post officials recently deposited \$100 to the fund to get the drive underway. This will be added to the \$438 collected two years ago by the Legion for the sign.

The drive was stopped at that time when it was believed that Birmingham High school would play their games at the new high school field.

Installation of lights and finishing of the field has now been delayed for an indefinite time and it has been decided to continue league games at Pierce.

The eight by 18 foot sign would be remote controlled with 18 inch high numerals recording the number of the downs, the number of yards to go and the score. Lighted football symbols will also indicate the team handling the ball. Installation of this sign is expected to be near the \$2,000 figure.

The Legion is in hopes that both residents and business firms will help in contributing to such a sign for the school's football games. Donations may be addressed to "Scoreboard Fund" in care of the Birmingham National Bank where the money is being held.

Troy Justice Fines Five Violators
