Apricot Charlotte
Soften 2 tablespoons of gelatin in 1/2 cup cold water. Mix 1/2 cup of syrup drained from a can of apricots with 1/2 cup of water and bring to a boil. Add the gelatin and dissolve. Let stand in cool place until the mixture is slightly thickened and cold. Add 1 cup of peeled apricots (put through a coarse sieve), then beat the mixture until it is light and frothy. Add 2 cups of cream, beaten stiff with 1/2 cup of powdered sugar and the grated rind of half a lemon. Fold the mixture over and over until well mixed. Line the side of a large mold with halves of lady-fingers, rounded sides out. Fill the mold with apricot mixture and congeal in the refrigerator.
