### County Chapter Has Given \$1,000 For Polio Tests

The Oakland county chapter, National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis, sent \$1,000 from local March of Dimes funds to national headquarters as their share of the estimated \$500,000 cost for field tests this fall on a possible polio vaccine.

Pierre Delamontier, chapter chairman said the money was sent in response to an urgent appeal by Basil O'Connor, president of the National Foundation.

Delamontier stated that the executive committee of the Oakland county chapter has voted unanimously to do its part to speed the triumph of science over polio.

"The practice of extending help on a nation-wide basis," he continued, "is basic to the National Foundation."

SINCE 1941 National headquarters has sent \$170,750 to augment local March of Dimes funds to care for Oakland county polio patients. At present the county chapter is paying bills for 152 Oakland county polio victims, 36 stricken this year and 116 in preceding years but still requiring care and treatment.

"Our grateful thanks to all who have contributed to the March of Dimes, making it possible for us to not only aid the victims of this disease, but participate in tests of a possible vaccine," Delamontier concluded.
