QUARTON LAKE ESTATES property owners may get their requested minimum-type street repairs after all. Several city officials this week were huddling over the possibility of having such maintenance done under the city charter's road-doling provision. This would, it is believed, enable residents to have the type of road surfacing they desire, yet the city would not have to guarantee its condition, as would be the case if a paving assessment had to be levied on the area. Formal discussions on the project were adjourned last week pending an engineering department survey of the area's streets and sewers.

ABOUT 50 FAMILIES in the neighboring Canadian city of Windsor this past week probably are wishing that Northland Center would vanish into thin air. The reason: they have been getting calls intended for the various stores in Northland—all because many South Oakland and northwest Detroit residents don't know the Northland phone exchange name—or they don't know the proper spelling of it. Birmingham's Michigan Bell manager, Al Warner, this week said one Windsor family had as high as 200 wrong number calls in one day. "The exchange name is ELgin—but people think it is spelled Algin. If AL is dialed, it is the same 'pull' on the phone dial as Clearwater, which is one of the two Windsor exchanges," Warner explained. "And with the recently installed direct automatic toll dialing, the calls in a split second go right across the Detroit River into the Windsor residences." Warner added that if anyone can dial the Southfield exchange (Flanders), they also can dial the ELgin exchange—and at the same cost as a Flanders call.
