

Polio Program Starts April 27 in Schools

Medical teams will open the polio vaccine program for this area when they swing into action at Poppleton and Big Beaver schools in Troy township on April 27. Teams will work these schools from 9 a. m. to noon, moving to Log Cabin school from 1 to 4 that afternoon.

Subsequent inoculations in these schools will be given May 4 and June 1.

An official okay was given to the program in Michigan Wednesday morning when state health officer Dr. Peter Heuts, called a special meeting in Lansing. Attending were health officers and medical society representatives from participating counties, plus state-level representatives of the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis.

AT A MEETING April 12 at Birmingham high school, arranged jointly by the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis and the SPC-PTA council, Mrs. Ralph Folkenroth, education chairman for the foundation, showed film strips on the vaccine administration.
 She also scheduling as many meetings as possible to show parents exactly how the program works, Mrs. Folkenroth said, "and to answer as many questions as we can on the coming field tests."
 Mrs. John Lambie and George Neffie represent the Oakland county health department, and answered parents' questions.
 They stressed again that "if the vaccine comes to Birmingham, it will be pure. Nothing will be sent to answer as many questions as we can on the coming field tests."

THE DOCTORS explained that these written guarantees would come with the vaccine from the maker, the laboratories of Dr. John Salk, discoverer of the vaccine and the U. S. Biologic Institute in Bethesda, Md. A fourth source, the American Medical association will not its approval to all vaccines released.
 In discussing the cards from parents, Mrs. Folkenroth said, "This is not considered as a signed permit. It is a request from a parent to have his child included in the program which we hope can bring an end to polio."

Eton Triangle Zone Unreasonable Judge Doty Holds

Oakland County Circuit Judge Frank L. Doty has determined that city zoning on a triangle piece of land bounded by Eton, the Graefield terraces and the Grand Trunk railroad right-of-way is unreasonable.

Judge Doty made known his opinion in the case of the Industrial Land company vs. the City of Birmingham Friday but has yet to enter his final decree.
 The circuit court action may force the city into rezoning the nine acres from residential to their business or multiple housing.

THE INDUSTRIAL Land company and Frank Newell and his wife, owners of the property, sought last year to have the property rezoned either to the commercial or multiple use and the petition was denied by the court.

The owners argued that the adjacent property was rezoned to residential use and that the property also was too close to the railroad for single family use.
 They argued that the city's zoning was "unreasonable and confiscatory" adding that he believed the zoning was desirable business land.

The city set May 3 as date for a public hearing to rezone the property to terrace zoning to gain time to decide on an appeal. The city will contact officers of the Penubroke Manor subdivision co-defendants in the suit, to discuss what action to take.

More Deficits Than Refunds

A move to gain \$7,741.09 in deficiencies in certain special assessment districts and to refund \$20,475 in surplus monies from two other assessment districts was approved by Birmingham city commissioners Monday night.
 Deficits resulted in the buying of Bradford and Mansfield, widening of Eton, paving of Lincoln from Tanton to Eton, Southlawn from Edgewood to Grant, Maryland from Lincoln to 14 Mile, Shiloh from Lincoln to 14 Mile, Northlawn from Birmingham to Stanley and Southlawn from Southfield to Stanley.
