April 19 Hearing

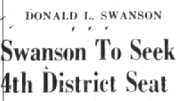
Assessments for the paving of Chesterfield, from Maple north to the north line of the city's westside fire station site, will be considered April 19 when the roll is up for confirmation.

Swanson To Seek 4th District Seat

Donald L. Swanson, 24068 Pennsylvania, Southfield township, this week announced his candidacy for the newly-created Fourth District state representative's seat in the August Democratic primary.

The 33 year-old Detroit school teacher is making his first bid for state office. His only other candidacy was for the Southfield Board of Education in 1953 when he was defeated after a recount.

A graduate of Wayne University, Swanson has been active in Detroit teachers' associations, his subdivision association and Townsite Community church activities. He served in the Navy in World War II.

"Residents of the new district," Swanson said, "are keenly aware of local needs, and expect a state representative to watch their interest closely. Since this is a new district, we now have an opportunity to aid in solving local problems more effectively than ever before."

The fourth district includes the townships of Southfield, Farmington, Novi and Lyon, and the cities of Lathrup, Oak Park, Farmington, Berkley and South Lyon.

"I'm running on the Democratic ticket because I believe in the Democratic program of improved school aid, adequate children's hospitals, improved mental health facilities, improved roads, and aid for the small businessman," Swanson said.

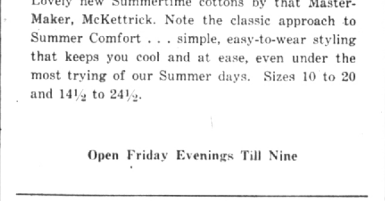
