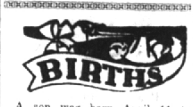

B'ham Members Tell History of Hammond Organ

April meeting of the Birmingham Hammond Organ Society consisted of a membership participation at Grinnell Brothers. E. J. Tolson read "The Hammond Organ Through the Years", describing the organ at its beginning in 1850 B.C. and told of the advancements to the present time. Mrs. Lucille McMurtrie gave an original musical "Fashions in Music." While A. B. Hilverkus played background music Mrs. McMurtrie explained that since prehistoric days, music has inspired man. It has been a powerful force through changes of several years and fashions.

Mrs. H. D. Terkurest played music from the period of the 1900's. Robert Moore presented "Some of These Days" illustrating the Sophie Tucker and World War I era. Mrs. Hilverkus played songs of the early twenties and Carl B. Stringer and Charles Koplak, songs of the middle twenties on the chord organ. The next era was the stock market crash and the age of radio. Joseph Zalesky presented "I'll See You In My Dreams," "Sleepy Time Gal," "Temptation" and "Fool Foot Two." R. D. Charman gave an illustration of the swing era by playing "Stomping at the Saucy," Carol Allen then played "Wish You Were Here" to bring us to recent times. At the conclusion of the musical commentary, informal entertainment was offered.
