## Catholic Women to Sponsor Card Party

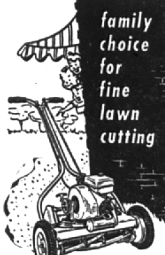

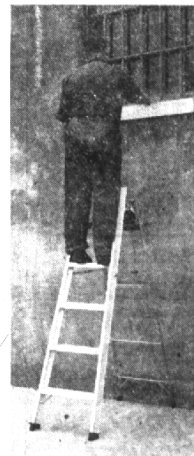

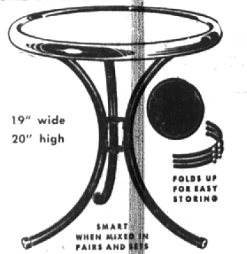
