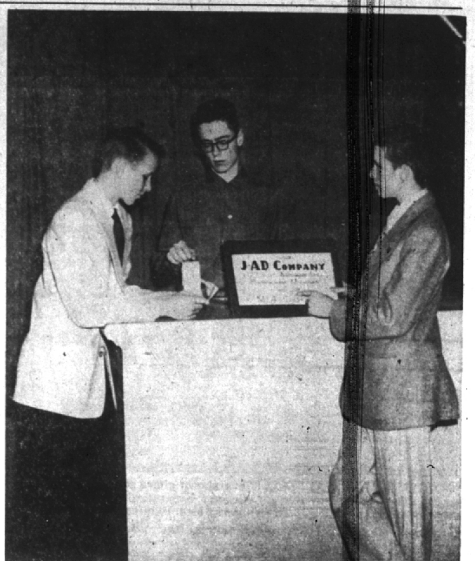

The Junior Achievement Story Will Be Enacted at Birmingham High School Assembly

At an assembly in the Birmingham high school auditorium April 30, freshmen, sophomores and Juniors will be entertained by a program planned by the members of the J-A-D Company, a junior achievement organization, which will tell the complete story of Junior Achievement in Birmingham during the past year.

The J-A-D Company has operated as an advertising agency during its working year. It has handled advertising services for other junior achievement companies as well as some Birmingham businesses.

The program Friday will open in much the same fashion as the television program, J-A-D PLAY-HOUSE, which the achievers wrote, directed and produced on Station W.B.K. TV Channel 2 during January, February, March and April this year.

The program plan is to introduce and interview officers of all Birmingham Junior Achievement companies and to show the products they manufactured, problems encountered, and methods of solving these difficulties in order to operate a profitable business.

J-A COMPANIES in Birmingham are Aqua Lamp Co., Compact Table Co., J-AD Co., J A Producers, James, J A Enterprises, Junach Products and Panda Products.

Main purpose of the assembly is to invite the members of next year's sophomore, junior and senior classes to participate in Junior Achievement. A secondary purpose of the assembly is to show sponsors of these companies what their work and funds have accomplished. The J-A sponsors are: The Birmingham National Bank; The Birmingham Eccentric; Detroit Corp.; Keller-Koch, Inc.; Tractor Division, Ford Motor Company; Rotary Club; and Wabek State Bank.

Shares of stock, sold during October and November 1953 at a par value of \$2.00 a share, supplied the capital necessary to purchase materials and manufacturing equipment needed to produce a product.
