**Famed Explorer's Watercolors Here For Month of May**

An exhibition of new watercolors, called "Arctic and Sub-Arctic," by the famed explorer, Colonel Bert Balchen, will be on view during the entire month of May at the museum of Cranbrook Institute of Science.

Noted as the designer of the airplane skis that enabled Commander Byrd to make successful his first flight over the North Pole, and as the first person since Lafayette who was made citizen of the U. S. by special act of Congress, Colonel Balchen has recently been aiding in the development of the polar air base at Thule, Greenland.

His first show of arctic watercolors in New York last year was a complete sell-out. Both his artistic technique and scientific accuracy were praised by leading critics.

Readers Digest said: "Besides being the world's greatest arctic pilot, Balchen is probably as uncommon a character as this century has produced. . . . Recently

he took up watercolors and without any instruction did about 150 fine paintings of the eerie splendor of the polar landscape.

The paintings in the current exhibit will be for sale. The museum of Cranbrook Institute of Science is open free to the public daily from 2 to 5 p.m.

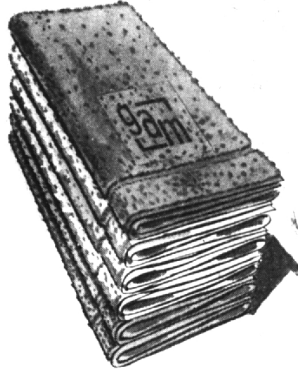

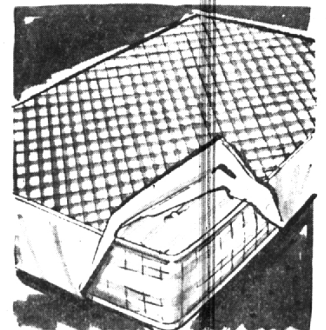

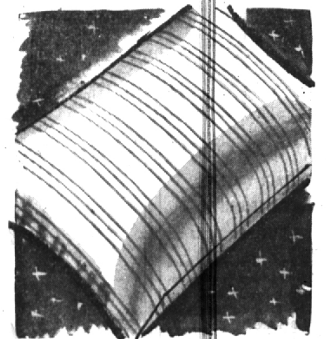
