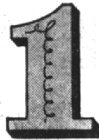
The Smiths spent the weekend past in Milwaukee visiting his brother and family, Mr. and Mrs. Leslie Smith.

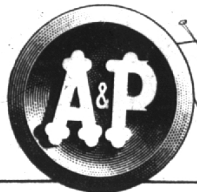
