THE FIRE HALL bond issue was favorably voted on by a six-to-one margin with 2496 votes approving the issue while 402 votes opposed the proposal.

The retirement system question likewise received a six-to-one majority with a "yes" vote of 2915 against a "no" vote of 479.

Birmingham residents gave the nod to annexation of the Porritt property by a 2875 to 638 vote.

As expected, Troy township voters balloting in the special election, rejected the proposal 307 to 64. The majority of both votes cast decided in favor of the annexation.

With the authority to issue bonds up to \$225,000, the city can proceed with plans to construct fire halls on both the east and the west side of the city—geographically placing the stations nearer residential centers.

THE EAST side station will be built on the corner of Adams and Bowers and the west side station at the Maple-Chesterfield corner.

Construction of the two halls will provide the department with more room to house equipment.

This also will relieve needed space in the city hall for expanded departmental activities. City officials believe that the police department will be given the nod for a good share of the room.

Modernization of the city employees' retirement system will increase benefits slightly and bring the program's operations up-to-date.

With the Porritt property with-

in the city limits, the developer, W. E. Reid Development company, can begin construction of duplex and single homes on the land under plans proposed before the annexation vote in a "gentleman's agreement" with the city of Birmingham on zoning.

WHEN QUESTIONED about the success of the fire hall vote, Fire Chief Vern Griffith said, "I am sure that I express the sentiments of all members of the fire department when I state that we will do everything possible to justify the confidence placed in us by the citizens of the city, the members of the Citizens Fire Committee and the city commission, to the end that Birmingham will have a fire department and fire service that an average city of our size should maintain."

The League of Women Voters distributed 4000 voter's information bulletins during Thursday, Friday, and Saturday preceding the election. About 700 were mailed to members and contributors to past finance drives, and the rest were distributed by members around the city.

Services and facilities financed by Easter Seal contributions include case finding, diagnostic clinics, medical care, physical, occupational and speech therapy, rehabilitation centers, camps, convalescent homes, special schools and classes for those unable to attend regular schools, vocational training, employment placement, appliances and equipment pools, psychological counseling and other services.
