

Little League Seeking Umpires

One of the greatest strains that can be placed upon a father-son relationship, the Birmingham Little League has found, comes when pop has to call the play on his son in a close baseball game.

To keep the two generations on speaking terms, the league this year plans to organize teams of umpires with definite working schedules.

Donald Parry, league vice-president who is planning the umpire program, hopes that by getting more fathers to umpire, he can both reduce the time demanded from any one man and keep fathers and sons from official encounters.

More fathers are needed as umpires for the two month league season which begins June 1. Men willing to devote one or two evenings a week to officiating at Little League games are urged to call Parry, 975 Madison.

THE LEAGUE tryouts will begin at 10 a.m. Saturday, April 17. American League candidates (those living south of a West Maple-Woodward-East Linden line) will report at St. James Field while those seeking National League berths (all candidates living north of the line) will turn out at Pierce schoolground.

If the weather permits, tryouts will be held of four successive Saturdays. Boys receiving bids from managers will then be called to squad tryouts. The remainder, including all who return parents' permission slips will be assigned to minor (farm) league teams.

All boys who have passed their eighth birthday and who will not be 12 until after July 31 are eligible. The league board is attempting to organize its 15-year minor league program so that every youngster who wants to play baseball will have his chance.

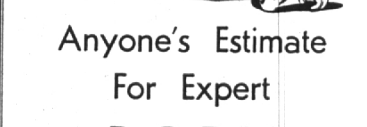

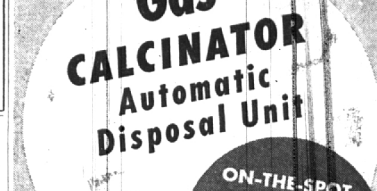
