Trucks Must Use Signal Equipment

Effective tomorrow, Aug. 13, Michigan State law will require that drivers of large commercial vehicles must use turn signaling equipment. Drivers are barred from signaling turns by hand and are required to use signaling equipment, such as signal lamps, to warn other drivers approaching from the rear.

This law requires owners to have the needed turn signaling equipment installed.

Every commercial motor vehicle, old or new, operated on a Michigan highway comes under this requirement when the distance from the center of the top of the steering post to the left outside limit of the body, cab or load exceeds 24 inches, or when the distance from the same point to the rear limit of the body or load exceeds 14 feet.

Measurements apply to any single vehicle or to any combination of vehicles.

Southfield Lots To Obtain Sewer, Water Installations

Sewer and water installation for lots on the east side of Southfield, below Lincoln, are on their way to the final stage following the city commission's action Monday on special assessments.

Assessments determined for the water main, which would extend from Lincoln to Southlawn, and for the sewer, which would go a block further south to 14 Mile road, was tabbed for three weeks until the city engineering department can prepare detailed plans and cost estimates.

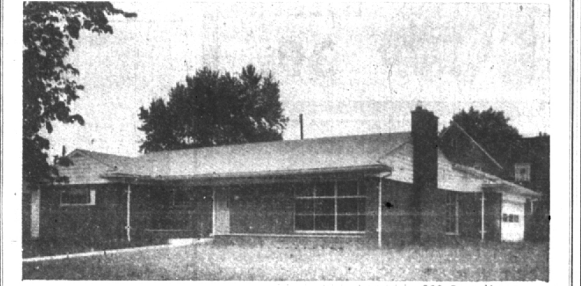
James is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Roger A. Yoder of Glenhurst drive.
