School Finances Revealed Tuesday

The Birmingham board of education treasurer's report released Tuesday night revealed a balance of \$143,725.33 in the general fund, as of August 1. Only \$491.40 remains in the building and site fund; \$393,166.85 in the construction account; and \$180,884.03 in the bond retirement fund with The Detroit Trust company.

Birmingham board of education Tuesday night okayed the transfer of funds from the general fund to other accounts in the amount of \$45,860.21. The board approved checks drawn on the general fund to cover accounts payable in the amount of \$32,126.60 and checks drawn on the construction account in the amount of \$187,612.45.
