Board To Avoid Overloading School Buses

BLOOMFIELD HILLS—Hopling to avoid a repetition of last year's school bus overloading problem, the board of education Monday night authorized School Supt. Eugene L. Johnson to do the best he could do on the \$20,000 available budget.

Johnson hopes to be able to negotiate with Greyhound for eight buses—four large and four small—for the daily 180 school-days run.

A survey of last year's overloading revealed a maximum peak load of 95 to 97 students per bus. The small bus seats 42 and the large, 52. The school system contracted for six buses—two small and four large—last year.

Campbell Promises Active Interest

LATHRUP—City Councilman John G. Campbell intends to continue as an active member of the council, councilmen learned Monday night.

Campbell, who recently moved to a suburb of Cleveland, Ohio, because of a temporary job transfer, reported that he would attend at least one of the two regularly scheduled meetings each month and would be available in case of emergency.

Councilmen questioned Campbell's absence at several meetings during the past two months, explaining that his vote on appropriations was an important one in the absence of a second council member. This was the case recently when Councilman David Redwood was forced to miss a few meetings because of illness.

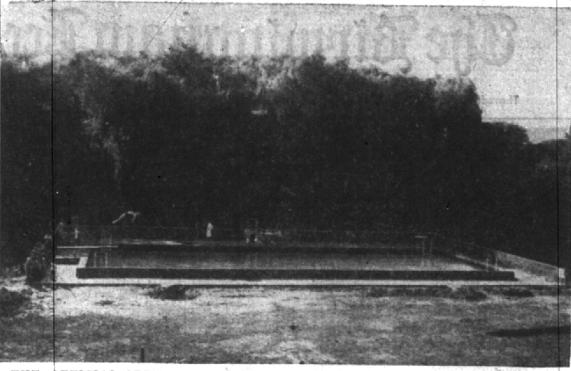
