

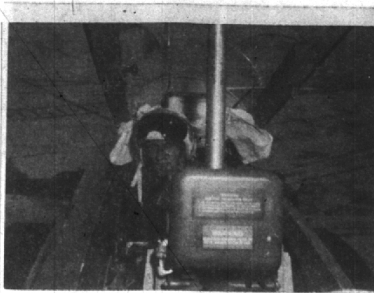


Publix Tourney Slated Sept. 4-5
