Barnum Alterations To Cost \$39,000

Work began Monday on an estimated \$39,000 renovation program on the old portion of the Barnum junior high school. Alterations contract on a time and cost basis was awarded to Gallagher and Schurrer Co., Pontiac at a special session of the B'ham board of education last week.

The alterations involve a general shifting of several school programs into new quarters—all made possible by the new industrial addition opened last spring, according to Herbert Hengst, school principal.

The former shop area is being readied for art classes and the library is moving into the former art room. The general office force will move into the library. The present office space is being enlarged for the counselor's offices.

THE FORMER kitchen space—utilized for the hot lunch program before the school opened the cafeteria—will be altered for the home economics department.

The program includes provisions for electrical and mechanical alterations, estimated about \$1000 each.

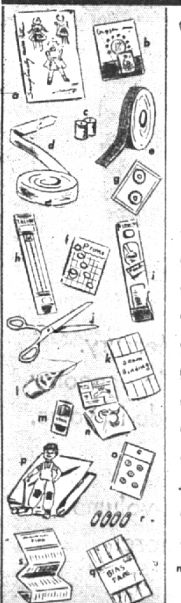
