Before adjusting, we remove the right front wheel to see condition of brake lining, drum and wheel bearings. Also—for your safety, we check steering gear for looseness and tires for uneven wear which may indicate wheels out of alignment.

If needed—brakes relined or overhauled on basis of parts and labor used.

PLAY IT SAFE Overfusing Circuits Invitation to Fires

The fuse provided in the electrical circuits of a home, store or other building, serves the same purpose as a safety valve. If an over-load is applied to any one circuit (electrical wire) this fuse, if of proper size, will blow or burn out and will remove 90 per cent of the chance that fire might result from defective electrical appliances or wiring. The greatest danger where electrical energy is used, develops because of one of two factors: Electrical appliances, or wiring which has not been properly maintained or installed, or because an overload or too great a demand has been applied to a circuit (electrical wire). IN MOST HOME circuits, unless a special power circuit has been run, 14 gauge wire is used. The 14 gauge wire, according to engineering data, is designed for a normal load not to exceed 1,650 watts, the capacity of a 15 amp. fuse or safety valve on that circuit. To install a heavier fuse on a 14 gauge wire circuit is the same thing as holding down a safety valve on a steam boiler; it removes from this electrical sys-

tem the safety that was built into it. Don't pyramid electrical outlets with adapters, one on top of another; have an extra outlet and circuit run from your master fuse box for the additional load. IF A FUSE on a power circuit has to be replaced and requires something larger than a 15 amp. fuse, check with your electrical utility company or an electrical contractor, who will properly inform you as to the right size and correct installation of these fuses. Power circuits are most generally installed for heavy demanding units, such as house heating units, fan and refrigerating units, etc. Play it safe! 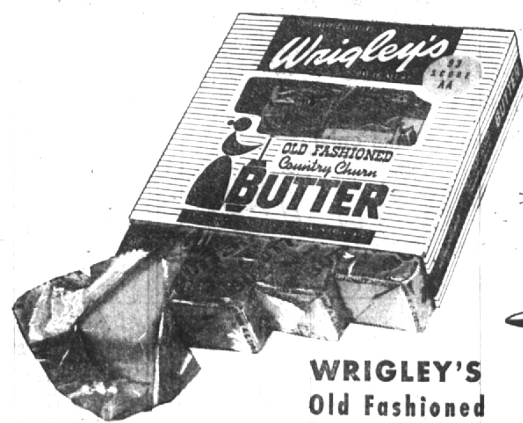

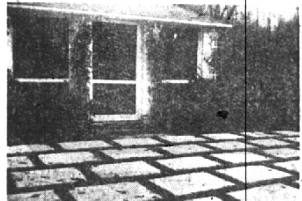
