Seek Members To Sub-Committee On School Needs

Members of the citizens steering committee of the PTA Council met at the Hill building Monday night and agreed to go ahead with the formation of the first of three proposed study groups—the sub-committee on building needs of the school district.

The committee elected to call the first group the citizens committee on education.

Chairman of this committee to study present and needed facilities is Louis A. Bauer, 3140 Broadway, Bloomfield Village.

Committee members are expected to be named at the January 2 meeting of the steering group when each member will submit the names of two or three people believed qualified for the review of classroom needs.

Torough study will then be started in various phases of facilities planning and population estimates.

This committee will work purely as an advisory group that will be independent of the school district's administration. It will be available to members of the sub-committee.

This is one of the studies requested of the PTA Council by the board of education last month.

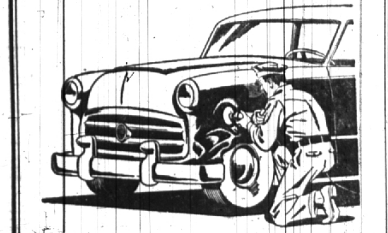
Any boy who is interested in the beginners instruction group is invited to meet at 7 p.m. Those who are working on advanced kits are invited to the 8 p.m. group.

Present thinking would indicate that such a committee would include at least 10 persons, with equal representation from each elementary school area.



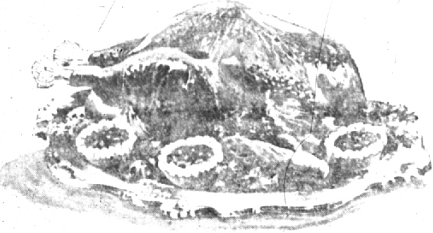
