Make Certain Your Holiday Is a Safe One

Holiday time is here—a gay time a happy time. Too often, especially among children, parties are turned from joy happy events into affairs of pain and tragedy. Whether or not a party makes this change is a feature entirely up to you, for they are the ones who make the selection of decorations and shoulder the responsibilities. Make sure, this year, your children have safe, happy parties. In case of home parties for the children at Thanksgiving, Christmas or the New Year, pay special attention to the costumes you buy.

LITTLE GIRLS, especially, face hazards in their dresses of gauzy, filmy material, or even paper. Just a chance draft of wind can displace a candle or an adult's cigar can turn a dress into a flaming torch. A simple home process can greatly reduce this hazard in a matter of a few minutes and with but little cost.

A solution of nine ounces of borax, four ounces of borie acid and one gallon of water is the answer. Material to be fireproofed should be thoroughly saturated with this solution, wrung out and hung to dry.

WHILE THE process does not remove national 100 per cent fire proof, it does insure a measure of safety against sudden flash fire. Moreover, it in no way destroys the softness nor flexibility of the material.

In games such as searches for hidden items, children should never be given candles to carry. Small flashlights are safe. Party decorations may be dangerous if not chosen carefully. Keep paper away from electric light bulbs and, of course, any type of heating unit.

Avoid using decorations for children's parties which might in dict injury if little folks bump into or fall against them.

ARRANGE parties so games will not excite youngsters to the point of becoming wild or reckless. Quiet games can be just as much fun if handled right.

Toys used in games or given as prizes also should be selected with safety in mind. Avoid things which small tots may put in their mouths. Bicycles or skating can result in sharp edges and points have their own form of hazard.

Keep the kids happy and safe. Shop wisely. Costume carefully. Decorate safely. Have fun!
