UNTAPPED SPORTS RESOURCE

On a recent cold November night we were introduced to a new style of fishing in Michigan which might well produce something akin to the California gold rush of '49 if enough sportsmen learn about it. It's hook and line angling for whitefish! While Crystal Lake in Benzie county was the scene of our initiation, whitefish occur in many northern Michigan lakes, and

the system should work in all similar waters.

Arks Used at Crystal Lake
At Benzie Mr. Faber Howard's ingenuity gave birth to the idea for a covered barge which could be anchored securely along the shores of adjoining Crystal Lake and Crystal Lake. The ark is about 10 feet of water, 6-foot long, 6-foot wide craft, fully enclosed with doors at each end. The roof was high enough for comfort in entering, and two wells open to the water below ran across the 6-foot width. Along the wells benches were built for the fishermen, and from four to six people can enjoy the facility at the same time.

Sport Lasts 4 Mos. Each Year
Short ice rods are used, with a sinker on the bottom of the moon filament line, and two dropper hooks in about a No. 6 size. Two-inch minnows are ideal. Whitefish fishing is open year round in some lakes, and the ideal time to take them is in November and December before the freeze-up, and again for two months immediately following the winter break-up, in early March and April. As a food fish they are at their best during these three months, and whitefish at their best are unbeatable!

Up to 5 Pounds in Size
The average fish on Crystal Lake will run 3 pounds, with a 5-pounder now and then. Considerable care must be taken in bringing your fish up from 40 feet of water because of the soft mouth of the species. While they can be taken just as readily from an open boat, the "ark" has terrific comfort appeal at this time of year. Enticing communities bordering on lakes, populated with whitefish, will soon sport the construction of a fleet of such craft, making them available at a reasonable rental price, thereby not only opening up a terrific new fishing sport but earning national recognition as well. There are plenty of whitefish in Michigan inland lakes. They're good sport to catch. Let's get busy!

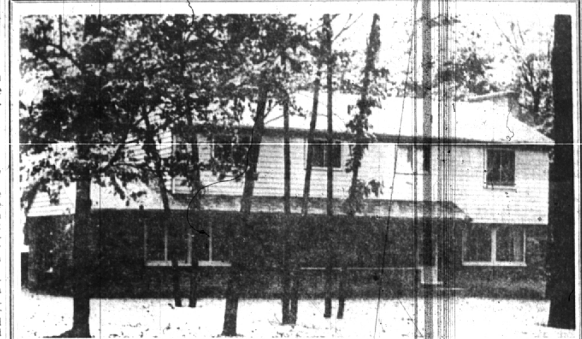
