Son Tom joined the rest of the family for the Thanksgiving holidays from school.

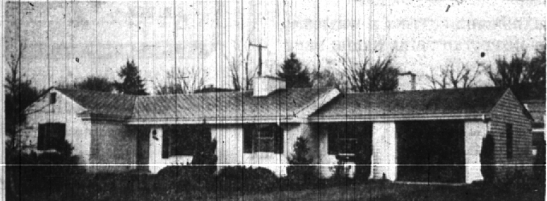
The Donald Harrons, on Kenning

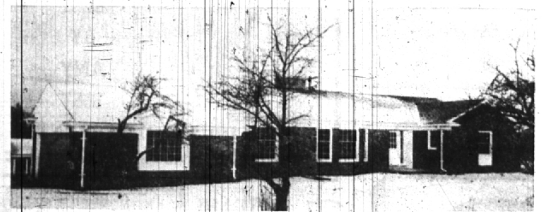

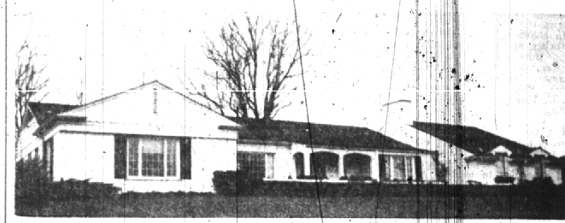
