Population Survey Slated For Area

The Current Population Survey will be conducted in this area during the week of February 15, according to Supervisor Edward T. St. Arnold of the U. S. Census Bureau district office at Detroit, Mich.
The Current Population Survey, taken monthly herein Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties, and in 229 other areas throughout the country, provides up-to-date national figures on employment and unemployment.
This information is used by business and government for analysis of current labor force conditions.
Supervisor St. Arnold pointed out that information furnished to the Census Bureau concerning individual persons is accorded confidential treatment under the law and only statistical totals are published.
Interviews for the Current Population Survey in this area are handled by personnel connected with the District office located at 1008 Federal Bldg., Detroit.
