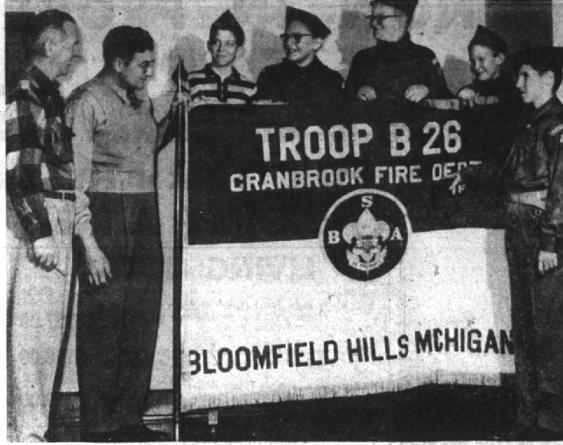

Lutheran Redeemer led during the first quarter but succumbed to a driving attack and trailed 20 to 30 at the half. In the third game of the evening, Congregational church held on to its second place position with a 30 to 25 win over St. James Episcopal church who has yet to secure its first victory. Tom Beck scored 11 markers for the winners while Dick DeLoria tossed in 9 points for the losers. Games are on Thursday nights in the Baptist church gym and are open to the public.
