U of M Professor To Be Heard Here

"The Responsibility of the Writer Today" will be the topic of John F. Muehl, assistant professor of English at the University of Michigan, when he speaks before the Friends of the Baldwin public library on Feb. 24. Held in the library auditorium at 8:15, the meeting is open to the public.

His first book, "American Sahib" was published in 1946, a journal of service with the British armies in India. He has appeared in numerous magazines since that time and has been heard in coast-to-coast broadcasts.

He returned from India in 1948, after nearly two years there, and wrote "Interview with India," a report of a 2,000 mile trip through the country by horseback, camelback, bullock cart and country-raft boat.

Mr. Adams, whose agency handles a number of automotive ac-

counts, will attend general sessions of the conference and call on his experience for contributions to conferences on media for distributing messages on highway safety.
