**PLAY IT SAFE!
Overfusing
Takes Away
Safety Valve**

The fuses in electrical circuits in homes, stores or other buildings serve the same purpose as safety valves. When a load is applied to any one circuit (electrical wire), this fuse, if of proper size, will blow or burn out and will remove 90 per cent of the fire hazard.

The greatest danger in the home, shop or other place where electrical energy is used, develops because of one of two factors:

(1) Electrical appliances, or wiring which has not been properly maintained; (2) Because an overload, or too great a demand, has been applied to a circuit (electrical wire).

IN MOST home wiring, circuits, unless a special power circuit has been run, are designed for a 14 gauge wire.

This wire, according to engineering data, is designed for a normal load not to exceed 1,650 watts; the capacity of the 15 amp fuse or safety valve on the circuit.

To install a heavier fuse on a 14 gauge wire circuit is the same as holding down a safety valve on a steam boiler. It removes from this electrical system the safety which was built into it.

If a fuse on a power circuit has to be replaced and should be larger than 15 amps, check with an electrician. He will properly inform you as to the right size.

Power circuits are most generally installed for heavy units, heavy heating motors, fans and refrigerating units, etc.

Play It Safe! Use the right fuse in the right place and avoid fires.
