Newberg To Pilot Pace Car

A 1954 Dodge V-8 convertible will be the Pace Car next May 31st when 33 of the fastest race cars in the world are flagged away to a start for this year's running of the 500-Mile Race at the Indianapolis Speedway.

Dodge's selection to pilot the 38th running of the annual automotive speed classic was announced in Indianapolis, Ind., Monday, by Wilbur Shaw, Speedway president and three-time winner of the event, at a traditional pace car dinner.

William C. Newberg, 375 Fairfax, Dodge president, will drive the Pace Car on race day, with Shaw as a passenger.

Newberg will be "right at home" at the wheel of the Pace Car. His whole life has been wrapped up in automobiles, and one of the morning achievements most dear to him happened last September when the 1954 Dodge V-8 chalked up 196 American Automobile Association stock-car records on Utah's Bonneville Salt Flats.

At the dinner, Newberg announced that the Dodge pace car will be equipped with PowerFlite, a fully-automatic transmission, and that an "exact replica" of the car would be put into limited production for sale through selected Dodge dealerships.

It will be called the Dodge "500".

Newberg was hired by the corporation as a road test mechanic on graduation from college. Soon after, he enrolled as a graduate student in the Chrysler Institute of Engineering, and in 1935 was awarded a Master's Degree in Automotive Engineering from the Institute.

During the next several years, Newberg was active in various engineering capacities for Chrysler. His first big opportunity came in 1942 when he was named chief engineer of Dodge's huge B-29 engine plant in Chicago.

At Chicago, he was responsible for all engineering activity and a broad variety of production assignments in a plant of vital importance to the nation's war effort. It was the principal source of Wright 18-cylinder engines for B-29 Superfortresses.

From 1946 to 1947, Newberg was assigned to engineering and production responsibilities with Chrysler Corporation's subsidiary operations, including Chrysler's Air-Teich Division in Dayton, Ohio.

Dog Laws Face Legal Test Today

A hearing on the legality of Michigan's state dog licensing law, originally set for last Thursday, is expected to be held before Oakland County Circuit Judge George B. Hartrick today, according to Ralph T. Keeling, attorney for the plaintiff.

Facing the test of the law in Rex Abbey, 3125 Mann road, Waterford, who is seeking a writ to make Oakland county treasurer Charles Sparks issue him a license for his dog without a certificate of vaccination.

Keeling contends the law does not apply uniformly to all citizens of the state and is, therefore, unconstitutional.

Last Thursday's hearing was postponed because an attorney for the defense was called out of town. A finding for the plaintiff may invalidate all dog ordinances, according to Keeling.

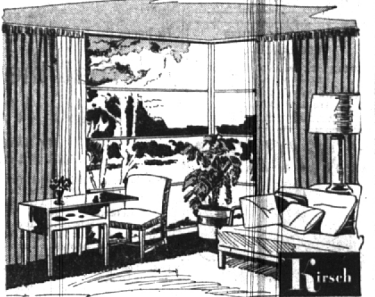

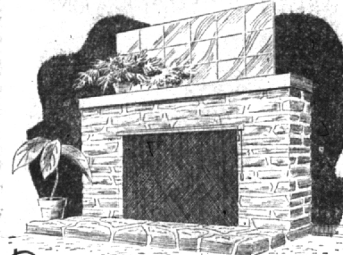

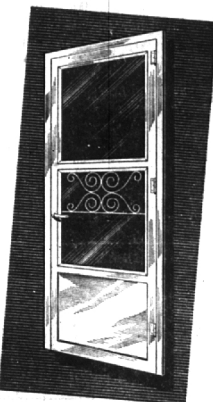
