Norm Matheson, 14, of Ferndale will demonstrate youth work with his novice dog, Sir Robert of Hunterfield, winner of 21 ribbons and five trophies.

CONSERVATION, retrieving and gun handling will be covered by Ralph Franks of Detroit with his springer, My Mae Dare.

Dr. James Stover of Highland Park, with Overland Sir Michael, will demonstrate obedience. A special color film showing some of the country's finest field and hunting spaniels in action will round out the program.

Regular training in these classes will start Feb. 14.
