Prepare Roll Call Mailing

Letters and booklets describing activities at the Community House are holding the attention of a staff of volunteers and office workers these days as the biggest Roll Call in history gets under way.

The mailing list to receive the general appeal for funds has reached a total of over 10,000 names in Birmingham and the surrounding area, including organizations which meet at the House and business establishments. This large mailing will go out to the public between Jan. 25 and Feb. 1.

"This year we are sending the mailing to all sections of the community at once instead of only to past contributors," says Mrs. Berrien C. Ketchum, Roll Call director.

"We hope in this way to avoid duplication of effort and keep costs to a minimum. Of course, letters to newcomers welcoming them to the Community House will be different from those sent to our old

friends who have supported the House for many years."

NEW THIS year also is a letter to be sent to outlying areas, explaining that the Community House is here to serve them as well as residents within the city limits. Services available to all include the use of free, sick-room supplies, rooms for meetings, the employment service, ranch room for teen-agers and senior activities for those of retirement age, to mention only a few.

The staff of volunteer workers crowds the Roll Call office to bursting and overflows into surrounding rooms.

The regular house-to-house canvass by two or three weeks, as the Roll Call dates are officially from Feb. 15 to Mar. 1.

"This advance mail solicitation gives us a chance to contact many who will be away later," explained Walter F. Skinner, Roll Call chair- man. "It also enables us to use fewer solicitors, for those who send their contributions to us in advance will not need to be called on later."

Skinner urged that all residents, organizations and business firms receiving the mailing consider the large budget needed this year to operate the Community House, \$45,000, and contribute as liberally as possible.

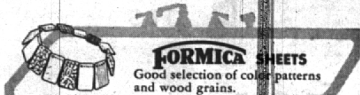
