

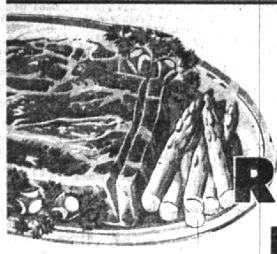

Membership Goal 425 in Y Drive

The Birmingham YMCA will launch its 1954 Membership Enrollment next Monday night, Feb. 1, with a kick-off dinner in the Dr. Ormond lounge at 6:45 p.m. The 'Y' is seeking to enroll 425 new and renewed members to bring its roll to a total of 1600.

As a motto for the enrollment, the 'Y' is having an automobile tour of Michigan with four cars labeled Y-M-C-A competing against each other in mileage. Points are being given for each new member and each dollar paid.

Serving as general chairman is Oscar Peterson, with Tom Ward, John Slater, Bill Gordon, and Art Blakeloe as drivers of the cars. Each driver has a team of five mechanics and 20 helpers to aid him in obtaining his team goal of 125.

The enrollment lasts from February 1 through February 26.

**Trustees Wanted In Southfield**

Southfield township officials are becoming accustomed to running the township with a small board of trustees.

The seven-man board that was reduced to three when the Michigan Supreme Court ruled against the seating of township justices in October, 1952, brought the burden of township business upon the supervisor, clerk and treasurer for four months.

The board room Tuesday night appeared just as empty as it was prior to the election of trustees in April, 1953.

Supervisor William Reeser was absent to attend a conference of supervisors in Lansing. Trustee James Campbell resigned recently because he lives in the area incorporated in December as the City of Lathrup Village. And Trustee Bernard Chapman has resigned on his intention to resign from the board and has not attended a meeting for four weeks.

**BOARD MEMBERS** will seek to fill at least one of the vacancies at their next meeting, February 9.

Me a n w h i l e, the abbreviated board is attempting to get an abreast of the township area in which the growth of residential, commercial and industrial business has been little less than sensational in the past two years.

**Trustees Wanted In Southfield**

After completing plans for the new garbage and rubbish pickup schedule to begin in the residential area on Monday, Feb. 1, city commissioners turned their attention to the collection of refuse in the business district, a job that falls to the department of public works.

A new rate schedule was approved by commissioners Monday night that will bring revenue from the service closer to actual operational costs.

The new rates, which have been approved by the Chamber of Commerce, call for free service for the first 61 cubic feet of refuse per business establishment and a five cent charge per month for each additional cubic foot.

REVENUE FROM these charges will bring nearly \$10,000 to the city annually to better cover the cost of the pickups which has been estimated at \$15,844 for the 1953-54 fiscal year.

Requirements for the merchants include the rule that metal containers weighing no more than 80 pounds when filled are to be used for rubbish, boxes must be compacted, and the name of the disposal can owner must be placed on each container.

Garbage, rubbish and ashes are to be kept in separate containers.
