Maples Find Going Easy Against Hurons

The Birmingham cagers made their Eastern Michigan league record two wins and two losses last Friday night by defeating Port Huron 55-39 on the Maples home floor.

Dick Muller and Don Dorough paced the Maples with 17 and 15 points respectively.

In the first quarter Chris Christie started Birmingham on the right road making the opening basket of the game. However, the Maples did not keep the lead too long for their attack bogged down and Port Huron took the chance and a three point lead which lasted till the end of the quarter.

In the second quarter the Maples started hitting and the Big Red to four. While the Maple offense improved, so did the defense, limiting Port Huron to only eight points in the quarter. At the end of the half Birmingham led 28-25.

AT THE BEGINNING of the third period Port Huron seemed inspired and scored two quick baskets and by the middle of the period trailed by only one point. Then the Maple attack improved again and the same three point margin was regained 30-33.

From the end of the third period on, Birmingham took complete control of the game. The Maple defense was faultless and the attack continued. Don Dorough and Dick Muller started hitting and the team could not be stopped although Port Huron tried hard.

In winning this game Birmingham is now tied for third place with Mt. Clemens in the Eastern Michigan league standing.

Tomorrow night the Maples travel to East Detroit to play the defending league champions.

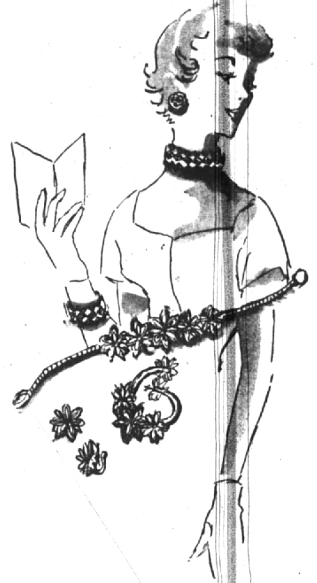

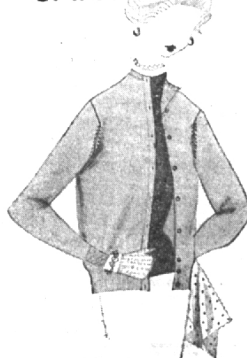
