Bloomfield Hills.

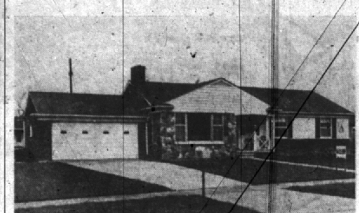


**THE ENGAGEMENT OF Patricia

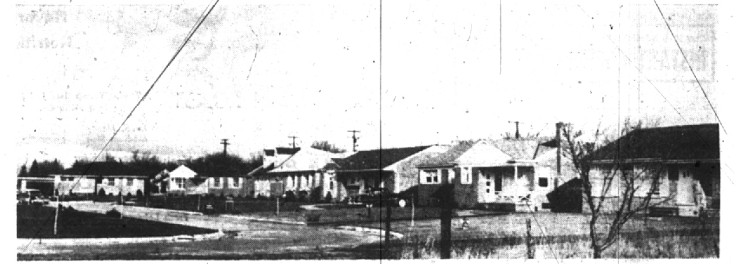

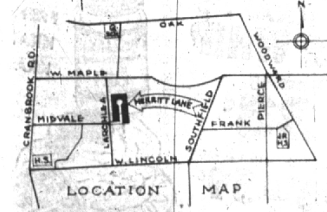
