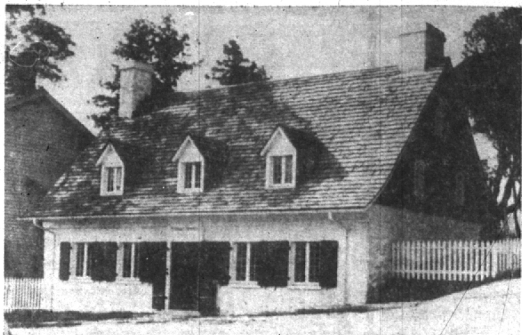

Special Education Proposal Adopted

The proposal by the Oakland county board of education to provide county-wide special educational facilities for handicapped children was approved by a 4 to 1 margin. County Superintendent of Schools William Emerson said Wednesday morning.

Local school districts voted on the issue on two separate dates, some voting June 14 and others July 12.

Officially, the proposal won by a vote of 12,689 to 3,391 with 498 ballots spoiled.

Only four of the 51 individual school districts voted the proposal down. They were the Carver district of Royal Oak, Addison near Oxford, North Oxford Number One, and Holly school district.
