LEGAL NOTICES

ORDINANCE NO. 453
OPEN PARKING STATION REGULATIONS
The City of Birmingham, Alabama, hereby enacts the following ordinance to regulate the operation of open parking stations and to provide for the collection and disposal of refuse and other material which may be deposited thereon.

ARTICLE I - DEFINITIONS
Section 181. OPEN PARKING STATION: Open parking station shall mean any area, lot, or tract of land, whether public or private, which is used for the purpose of temporarily storing or parking motor vehicles.

ARTICLE II - CLASSIFICATIONS
Section 182. CLASSIFICATIONS: Open parking stations shall be divided into two classes as follows:
A. Class I. Such open parking stations as are situated in Business, Industrial, or Public areas, and which are used for the parking of motor vehicles.

ARTICLE III - LICENSING
Section 183. LICENSING: No person shall maintain or conduct an open parking station in Birmingham without first having obtained a license therefor from the City Clerk.

ARTICLE IV - APPLICATIONS
Section 184. APPLICATIONS: Application for a license or the renewal of a license shall be made on a form provided for that purpose and shall set forth the name and legal status of the applicant, the location of the open parking station, and the number of motor vehicles which will be parked thereon.

ARTICLE V - FEES
Section 185. FEES: The fee for a license for an open parking station shall be as follows:
A. Annual license fee for Class I: \$10.00.
B. Annual license fee for Class II: \$5.00.

ARTICLE VI - MAINTENANCE AND SANITATION
Section 186. MAINTENANCE AND SANITATION: Every open parking station shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition and shall be free from any refuse, rubbish, or other material which may be deposited thereon.

ARTICLE VII - INSPECTION
Section 187. INSPECTION: The Police Department shall have the right to inspect any open parking station at any time and for any purpose, and shall be allowed to enter the same for the purpose of ascertaining that the same is being maintained in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.

ARTICLE VIII - VIOLATIONS
Section 188. VIOLATIONS: Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

ARTICLE IX - ENFORCEMENT
Section 189. ENFORCEMENT: This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Police Department of the City of Birmingham, Alabama.

ARTICLE X - NOTICES
Section 190. NOTICES: Any notice required by this Ordinance shall be given in writing and shall be delivered to the person named in the notice or to his residence or to his place of business.

ARTICLE XI - LIABILITY
Section 191. LIABILITY: The City of Birmingham shall not be liable for any damage or loss caused by any motor vehicle parked in an open parking station.

ARTICLE XII - LIMITATIONS
Section 192. LIMITATIONS: This Ordinance shall not apply to any open parking station which is used for the parking of motor vehicles which are being stored for the purpose of sale or repair.

ARTICLE XIII - PARKING TOLLS
Section 193. PARKING TOLLS: The City of Birmingham shall have the right to collect parking tolls from any motor vehicle which is parked in an open parking station.

ARTICLE XIV - UNLAWFUL VEHICLES
Section 194. UNLAWFUL VEHICLES: No person shall park in an open parking station any motor vehicle which is the subject of a court order or judgment of forfeiture.

ARTICLE XV - SEVERABILITY
Section 195. SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

ARTICLE XVI - EFFECTIVE DATE
Section 196. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect on the first day of August, 1954.

All such signs shall be subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 221, entitled "ENTRANCES AND SIGNS".

ARTICLE XVII - PENALTIES
Section 197. PENALTIES: Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

ARTICLE XVIII - APPEALS
Section 198. APPEALS: Any person who is aggrieved by any action taken by the City of Birmingham under this Ordinance may appeal to the Board of Appeals.

ARTICLE XIX - MISCELLANEOUS
Section 199. MISCELLANEOUS: This Ordinance shall not be construed to limit the authority of the City of Birmingham to regulate the operation of open parking stations in any other manner.

ARTICLE XX - REPEAL
Section 200. REPEAL: All ordinances and resolutions heretofore enacted which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE XXI - ADVICE OF RIGHTS
Section 201. ADVICE OF RIGHTS: This Ordinance shall be read to any person who is arrested for a violation thereof, and the person shall be advised of his rights.

ARTICLE XXII - SEVERABILITY
Section 202. SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

ARTICLE XXIII - EFFECTIVE DATE
Section 203. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect on the first day of August, 1954.

ARTICLE XXIV - AMENDMENTS

Section 210. REPEAL: All ordinances and resolutions heretofore enacted which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE XXXI - ADVICE OF RIGHTS
Section 211. ADVICE OF RIGHTS: This Ordinance shall be read to any person who is arrested for a violation thereof, and the person shall be advised of his rights.

ARTICLE XXXII - SEVERABILITY
Section 212. SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
