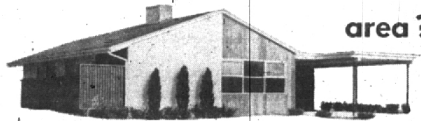

### City to Open Bids On Resurfacing

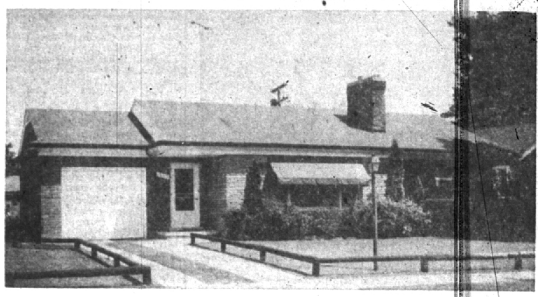

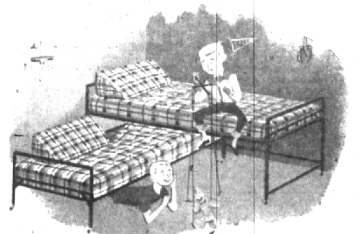
