

### Session Studies Problem of Older People's Future

"Aging is an achievement; our senior citizens deserve the respect that comes from the opportunity for life-long development and usefulness; preventive measures applied to today's younger persons are required to achieve these wholesome goals for America's aging population.

Mrs. H. H. Corson, one of several Birmingham persons to attend the University of Michigan's division of gerontology summer session last week, said this opinion prevailed throughout the entire meeting.

"Dr. Wilma Donahue of the university staff," she said, "presided over part of the session and from her broad experience in this field gave us a very clear picture of what the future holds and can hold for our older citizens."

OTHERS from the area attending the meeting were Mr. and Mrs. Howard Estes (Estes is manager of the Oakland county infirmary), Mrs. William H. Burlingame, who has done horticultural therapy

work at the infirmary, Mrs. Ralph F. Marson and Mrs. Spencer Wood. Church representatives included from Christ Church Cranbrook, Mrs. A. Dale Kirk, Mrs. Russell H. Meyer and Mrs. Howard Stegall, with the Rev. John D. Rose from the Community Church, Congregational, in Southfield.

Continuing her comments, Mrs. Corson said these attending the conference recommended the use of all types of mass media to reach a new understanding of our responsibility to make sure problems of today's senior citizens are not continued.

"THE DISCUSSION on how to achieve the objectives of the group revealed a difference of opinion," Mrs. Corson said. "It was the consensus though, that aging is everybody's business and that individuals and organizations at all levels of society should be concerned.

"We must be aware of our responsibility to bring about an environment for tomorrow's older people that will give them ample opportunity to be useful, productive and respected, both by themselves and the community in which they live."

### JULY JUMBLE

If you want your bachelor buttons to bloom again (and we wonder if many will) (it seems to us that one hatch of buttons a season is enough) shear off the top 6 inches and apply some ammonium sulphate or nitrate of soda.

Water dahlias in drought periods once a week (deeply) and apply VIGORO or AGHICO.

Dust or spray hollyhocks with BORDEAUX.

Floribunda roses will flower all summer if old flower clusters are clipped off. (We have a nice CLIPPER for this) (it is called a thinning shear and is designed (imagine this) for clipping old flower clusters off of floribunda roses.)

Transplant irises this month.

Keep gladiolus plants well watered when they are coming into bud.

Going back a little we wish to suggest that the THINNING SHEARS mentioned above have other uses.

We don't wish to be crabby, but we feel that we must give you all the dope on CRAB GRASS. Well, information anyway. (We sell the dope)

1. It is probable that Crab Grass is now showing in your yard and that most of it is in the seedling stage. The materials you use for combating this grass will cover twice as much in this stage as in the mature stage.
2. While thickness of turf is one of the best controls, it will not eliminate the pest.
3. Therefore, selective herbicides must be used if you are going to make progress.
4. Here is a list of actions and materials which appear to be effective controls.
  - a) Fertilize immediately with REGAL LAWN FOOD, GRO-SOD or STADLER'S XXX.
  - b) Water adequately once or twice a week.
  - c) Cut grass as high as possible—2" would be excellent.
  - d) Apply one of the following herbicides (your equipment may have an important bearing on the type of material to be used).
    - CRAB-NOT—A water soluble potassium cyanate, can be applied with almost any liquid sprayer.
    - CRAB-NOT SPECIAL—Same as above but with 2-ID added for killing broad leaved weeds.
    - DUST-A-WAY—Potassium cyanate in powder form to be applied with a fertilizer spreader.
    - ERADICO—A liquid solution of Chlorodane in refined petroleum (white kerosene). This cannot be a diluted and equipment must be capable of distributing 1 gallon over 1,000 sq. ft.
    - STANDARD CRAB GRASS SPRAY—A pure, refined petroleum to be applied without dilution.
    - ENDO-WEED CRAB GRASS KILLER—A water soluble potassium cyanate.

Note: All of these materials are to be used with caution. The amount designated for a specific area must not be varied.

A good kill of CHICKWEED can be expected from the potassium cyanate products—especially CRAB-NOT SPECIAL.
