Public Hearing Set On Zoning Ordinance For Bloomfield Hills

A new zoning ordinance for Bloomfield Hills was approved for public hearing Tuesday night by the city commission.

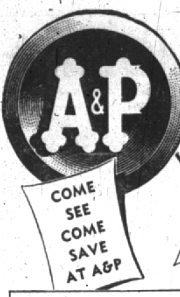
