SOUTHERN PECAN PIE

4 eggs
1 1/2 cups coarsely broken pecans
4 tablespoons butter
1 1/2 cups cane (or maple) syrup
1 cup white sugar
1 teaspoon vanilla
Boil sugar and syrup together for 3 minutes. Beat eggs not too stiff, and slowly pour the hot syrup into the eggs. Add butter, vanilla and pecan meats. Turn into an unlined pie shell and bake in a moderate oven for about 45 minutes or until set. Recipe serves from 6 to 8 people.

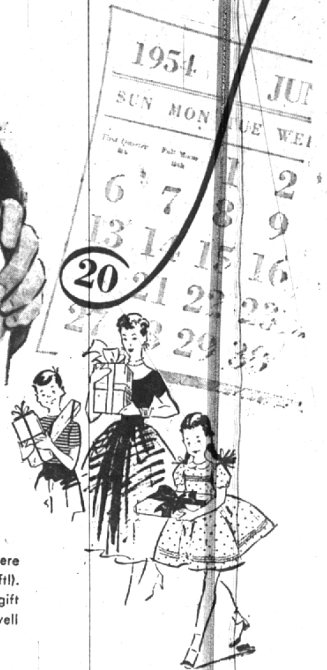
