

Comedy to Open Summer Season For Will-O-Way

Will-O-Way Playhouse will open its 1954 summer season on June 4 with a married life comedy, "The Fourposter", starring Burton and Bette Wright.

The Jan de Hartog play is being directed by William Turner, and deals with 25 years of progress of married life, starting in the middle-1890's.

Burton Wright has been connected with several Playhouse productions during the past five

years, his last appearance being "Here Today". He has also been in "Royal Family", "Boy Meets Girl", and "The Male Animal".

PRODUCTION director of Detroit's WWJ-TV, Wright has spent several seasons at Blich's gardens and has appeared often on radio. He starred in the "Betty and Bob" serial and for some time was the judge in the Court of Missing Heirs program.

"Blythe Spirit", "Over Twenty-one" and "Handle with Care" have been recent Will-O-Way starring vehicles for Bette Wright. In the past she was also cast regularly in radio serials "Road to Life", "Ma Perkins", and "Backstage Wic".
