Montgomery Heads Kroger Property

Appoint of Robert Montgomery, 1026 Puritan, as director of property for the Kroger Co. has been announced by Joseph B. Hall, president of the retail food firm. Montgomery, who had been assistant to the president of the Houaille-Hershey Corporation in Detroit since 1952, attended the University of Pennsylvania and Case Institute of Technology. Montgomery is a member of the University of Pennsylvania and the Society of Automotive Engineers, as well as an associate member of the American Institute of Management. In his new position, Montgomery will supervise real estate construction and engineering, and safety programs for the Kroger Co. and its 1,785 stores in 19 states.

Electronic Art Display Featured

Electronic art, a new combination of science and abstract design, will be illustrated in 50 photographs on display at the museum of Cranbrook Institute of Science during the entire month of June. The design compositions are formed by electrical waves made by a device similar to a TV receiver. This device, called a cathode-ray oscilloscope, creates shapes which can be combined and captured on film in elaborate patterns ranging from white to black. Mathematician-artist Ben F. Lapooky, of Cheroke, Iowa, developed the new art form after years of research with electronic circles and geometric designs. Since 1954 Lapooky has written many articles on his work for scientific journals and has had numerous reproductions of his compositions published. The museum of Cranbrook Institute of Science is open free to the public daily from 2 to 5 p.m.
