JOHN JOHNSON, a pupil in Miss Ford's room has been out with the mumps all last week. Their room is now studying Michigan in Geography.

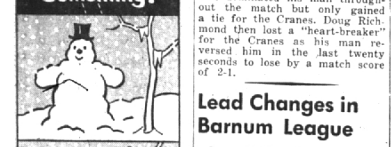

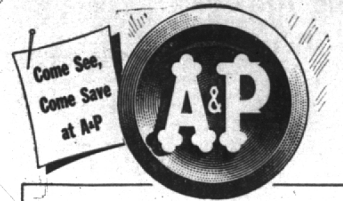
