DOWN TO EARTH
More Help for Your Spring Garden Plans

The garden report of last week did not complete the fine garden points made by Milton Barrons during his recent talk to gardeners in Birmingham, so suppose I continue to pass on to you some "meaty" ideas you can use on your own property.

It is possible to secure a novelty for accent in your yard, a white rebud tree, called by some the "Judas Tree."
This specimen is a mutation. Anyone from the southern part of Ohio or parts of Kentucky "purrs" when you mention the rebud tree as it is so typical of the early spring picture there.
When you are traveling to Florida by car it is always fun to see who in the car can see the first rebud as new cycles of mild weather are approached.
If you have acid loving plants, Barrons suggested that you supply them by making a bed of a mixture of peat moss and sawdust, about half and half, and add powdered sulphur to it.
The St. Johnswort shrub was featured as being a fine, low growing (three foot) specimen, ideal for a sunny location, and itself very well for hedge use.
THIS SHRUB has golden yellow flowers and at the center will be found hundreds of golden stamens. The leaves are bluish green and are oblong, narrow and about two inches long. So, you can see that this shrub has an interesting texture for you to incorporate into your panorama of green textures and colors.
One of the finest ground covers you can employ is baltic ivy. This hardy cover has a leaf with prominent veins. When you are using it on a bank, as a border to a boundary planting or as a ground cover under a tree or in the shadow of a building, use the following technique for planting.
Aerate the ground, spade where the surface is hard, and well and break up any lumps of soil. Then, fertilize with an all-purpose fertilizer and add humus if the surface needs enriching. I would be inclined to let a day lapse after the addition of fertilizer before placing the plants 12-18 inches apart in all directions.
BARRONS feels that the charlotte and betal crabapple tree varieties are susceptible to cedar apple rust and need to be sprayed at intervals to counteract this. Use a mixture with a base of sulphur, ferimate or fixed copper.
To find a good shrub which will take a semi-and near-deep shade is always a problem. One of the finest shrubs for this purpose is cornus mas, the cornelian-cherry (out from Ithaca, N. Y.). The tiny flowers are a bright yellow, and bore in the axils of unfolded leaves. They flower in March and early April.
When judging the value of one variety of a given shrub in comparison to a new introduction of the same shrub we often measure performance.
SPRING GLORY forsythia is a new introduction I like because the flower branches "perform" right down to the ground, giving a mass of flowers. It is a rapid grower.
Following along with Barrons, there is the nevalis quince which is white and gives a surprise effect when you know the identity of the shrub as the flowers are generally red or salmon color. Remember white accents are important to give style to your garden.
The higan cherry was recommended in its weeping form as being an excellent accent for a terrace. When you give any tree the compliment of having the honored spot along side of a terrace you are the one to select the specimen.
Some prefer a crooked trunk or some profile characteristic to denote an original influence. A "weeping" characteristic of the branches is good.
THERE IS a very choice tree which flowers before the dogwood, and loves the shade. It is the silverbell or halesia tree, which will grow 20 feet plus. The bark comes off in scales like the shagbark hickory which makes it interesting in coloring. The buds are pinkish, flowers white.
The mountain silverbell is ideal for street and roadside planting. I have looked up the sources of this plant material and the "Plant Buyer's Guide" at Baldwin library has many choices to give the purchaser.
Barrons seemed to feel that the french lilacs which we buy grown
