

## Bloomfield Hills Budget Request Hits New High

The upward trend of costs for city government in Bloomfield Hills continues as a record budget request of \$143,530 for 1964-65 was submitted to the city commission Tuesday night by City Manager Elmer Kephart.

Commissioners tentatively approved the budget which calls for a hike in the city's tax rate from \$15.20 per \$1,000 assessed valuation this year to \$16.80 for the coming year.

A public hearing was set for May 25 in the budget which must be approved by June 1. The request is about \$9,000 over current year's operating expense which by estimate will amount to \$134,560.

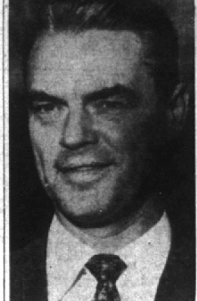
## Driver Sentenced To 90-Day Term

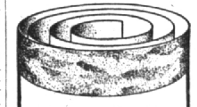
