He stated he is especially pleased with his new assignment because he has always admired Birmingham as a fine residential city.

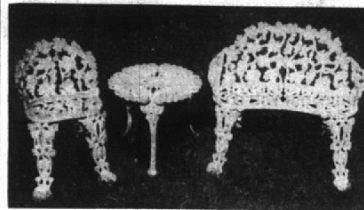

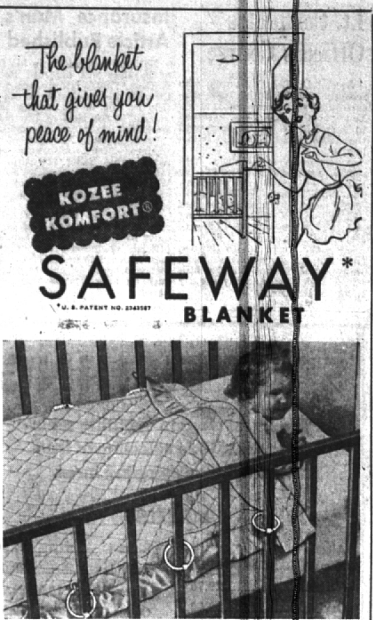
