## Pontiac Lawyer Seeks Nomination To State Senate

Anthony Renne, Pontiac attorney, announced this week his candidacy for state senator on the Republican ticket in the August primary election. He has served on the Pontiac's Chamber of Commerce's safety, committee and business committee, and one of the main points in his platform is seeking the passage of traffic safety measures through state legislative action. Honesty in government is the third step in Renne's campaign for state office.
